### **Indian Point's Unit 2 to Shut Down for Planned Refueling**

Buchanan, N.Y. – Control room operators at the Indian Point Energy Center will shut down unit 2 nuclear power plant for its 19<sup>th</sup> scheduled refueling outage at around midnight tonight.

Unit 2 has been online generating electricity more than 99 percent of the time since it returned to service from its last refueling outage in April 2008.

“Unit 2 has been a safe and reliable source of electricity for New York over the past two years,” said Joe Pollock, vice president and top Entergy official at Indian Point. “During the outage the workforce at Indian Point will grow to more than 2,000 skilled workers and building trades people who will accomplish hundreds of scheduled maintenance and other improvements to the power plant.”

During this planned refueling outage about one-third of the used fuel in unit 2 will be replaced with new fuel.
