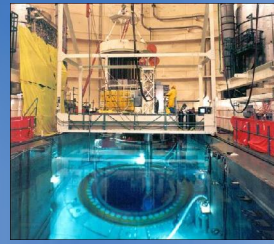

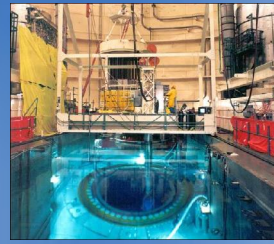

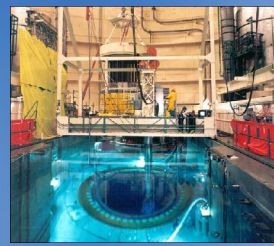
Independent Safety Evaluation

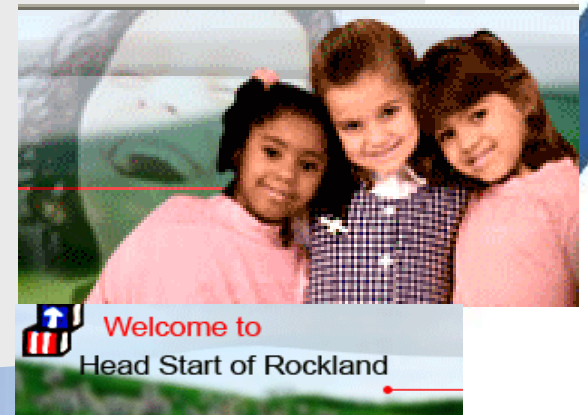
- **Entergy is a presence in our community**

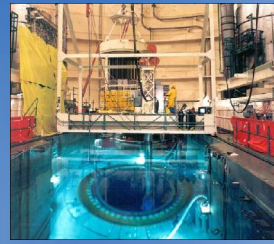
